The Etude Club of Berkeley, founded in 1904, is an association of music lovers whose objectives are to encourage high musical standards among performing members, to encourage young people in their musical studies, and to stimulate the appreciation of fine music in the community.

Meetings are held at the Hillside Club (2286 Cedar Street, Berkeley), once a month usually on the 4th Monday, at 12:30pm from September through May. The meeting includes a musical program performed by members and guests of the Club and is followed by a tea and social time.

There are 3 types of membership:

- 1) **Solo Performers** may perform as soloists and must be recommended by the Auditions Committee after an audition.
- 2) **Ensemble performers** also audition for the Auditions Committee, however, the audition may be waived at the Committee's discretion when an applicant has recently performed as an Etude guest or been heard by committee members in **another local performance**.
- 3) **Non-Performing** members do not ordinarily participate in musical performances, but provide important audience support and participate in all other activities of the Club.
